Charity Football Games to Raise Money and Awareness for Veterans in Need

Sacramento, Ca. (August 12, 2014) - The NFHS Network, the nation's leading destination for live coverage of high school sports and events, announced a partnership with the Honor Group Inc. The Honor Group is a community organization dedicated to educating, empowering and equipping military veterans for success.

The NFHS Network (nfhsnetwork.com) announced today that it will Livestream each game for the northern California (NorCal) segment of the 5th Annual Honor Bowl, a high school football showcase that educates students and community about the needs of military veterans. This year's Honor Bowl will take place in two portions of California on two different back-to-back weekends. Established in 2010, The Honor Bowl has hosted more than 70 schools and an estimated 70,000 sport fans.

The Northern California Honor Bowl will occur on Friday, August 29th and Saturday, August 30th PT. The Southern California segment will take place the following weekend on September 5th and 6th at Oceanside High School, Oceanside, Ca. The Southern California Honor Bowl games will be broadcast live by Time-Warner Cable Sportsnet throughout southern California, Las Vegas and Hawaii.

The two-day Northern California Honor Bowl fundraiser will feature five games and 10 high schools from three states. The schedule is as follows:

- 5:00pm Elk Grove vs. Damonte Ranch, NV.
- 8:00pm Del Oro vs. Kamehameha, HI.

Saturday, August 30th, 2014

- 2:00pm Clovis North vs. Reed, NV.
- 5:00pm Cardinal Newman vs. Churchill County, NV.
- 8:00pm Clayton Valley vs. Carson City, NV.

The NFHS Network has a heart for our military veterans and will donate a portion of its online subscription proceeds in support of The Honor Group's mission. You can watch the NorCal games LIVE by going to www.nfhsnetwork.com. A Day Pass to watch the games will be \$9.95, or you can watch all five NorCal games for \$14.95.

Also, in a history making portion of the Livestream broadcast, NFHS Network will lock arms with Clear Channel Media and Entertainment that will be supporting The Honor Group's fundraising efforts with a national and local radio broadcast. Clear Channels Sacramento affiliate NewsRadio KFBK 1530AM sport anchors Bill Herenda and on-air personality Pat Walsh will host the live remote broadcasts that will occur on 8:00pm on both Friday the 29th and August 30th. During both of these games the stations will encourage the viewers and listeners to support veterans by donating online at <u>www.thehonorgroup.org</u>.
